There is limited 2-hour and metered parking
on Main Street in front of the theater. There
is a 510-space municipal parking garage on
Storrs Street, just behind the theater. Storrs
Street runs parallel to Main Street, on its
eastern side. Red River Theatres' entrance
can be accessed from the parking garage.

To reach Storrs Street coming from the
south end of Main Street, turn right onto
Storrs Street at the intersection shortly after
the Dunkin Donuts, about ¼ mile before the
theater. The parking garage will be on your
left, across from the shopping plaza.

To reach Storrs Street from North Main
Street, turn left onto the Pleasant Street Ex-
tension (1/2 block north of the theater). At
the bottom of the hill, turn right and the ga-
rage will be immediately to your right.
