

This seven credit symposium is designed to update participants on new concerns and issues in AIDS, HIV infection, and the practice of dentistry with a focus on women. The history of HIV in Massachusetts and emerging issues in the oral care of the female patient, including those who are HIV positive, will be discussed.

Upon completion of the day's program, participants will be able to:

- discuss the history of HIV and oral health in Massachusetts
- diagnose and treat female HIV patients
- discuss oral health through the life stages of women
- discuss oral systemic issues in women
