
HIV & Oral Health Webinar Series Part 6

HIV, Oral Health, and Health Equity for Older People

Wednesday, May 10, 2023 ~ 12:00 - 1:00 pm ET



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Healthcare delivery systems and providers must develop expertise in the care of older adults. Ageist beliefs influence the care and outcomes for PWH including their oral health. This session will focus on equity in healthcare and share tools to recognize and reduce inequities so that all older patients are treated with dignity and respect. This session will encourage participants to think about their own beliefs about aging and to propose solutions to reduce inequities in care. A variety of approaches and use of evidence-based elements will be used to discuss innovative models such as the Reframing Aging Initiative. This session will share tools and techniques that foster equitable, inclusive care and support better outcomes for older adults to foster more equitable care.

Objectives: At the conclusion of this session, participants will be able to:

- 1. Define ageism and its root causes and discuss how ageist beliefs translate into inequitable healthcare practices.
- 2. Identify at least 3 examples of how ageism is expressed in the delivery of care to older people with HIV and those with oral health needs.
- 3. Identify strategies that providers can employ to decrease ageism and improve equitable healthcare for older people.
